2018-2019

- 1. Miller School District staff and parents will educate the Miller students to recognize and promote positive character traits.
- 2. The Miller School District will implement and maintain transition programs from the Elementary to the Junior High School.
- 3. 100% of our students will graduate in 2019.
- 4. The K-12 staff will document South Dakota state standards on lesson plans or curriculum plans.
- 5. 95% of our 7-12 grade students will be eligible for extra-curricular activities each semester.
- 6. 85% of all Junior High and Senior High Students will be involved in at least two extra curricular activities per school year.
- 7. The Miller School District will facilitate grade level and/or content area meetings to discuss and analyze student level assessment data.
- 8. By 2018-2019, the Miller School District will score at or above the state average (# of Level 3 and 4 students or proficient and advanced) on the Smarter Balanced assessment in the areas of ELA, Math, and on the Dakota STEP assessment in Science.
- 9. The Miller School District will maintain a 95% or above attendance rate during the 2018-2019 school year.
- 10. The Miller School District will utilize differentiated methods of instruction and assessment in the classroom.
