1946 CHAMPIONSHIP FOOTBALL TEAM

The 1946 football season was an exceptional one for the Miller Rustlers. Their record shows eight wins and no defeats. Considered one of the highest scoring and most outstanding teams of the nation, the Rustlers, averaging 46.2 points per game, racked up a total of 371 points, holding their opponents scoreless. In addition to this remarkable feat, the potent Rustler defense did not allow their opponents to cross the thirty-yard line.

Under the youthful mentorship of Coach Robert Schroeder, the Rustlers were picked for all-state laurels by two of the leading newspapers of South Dakota. The team, undoubtedly the strongest in our school history, captured the CSDC crown for the second consecutive year.

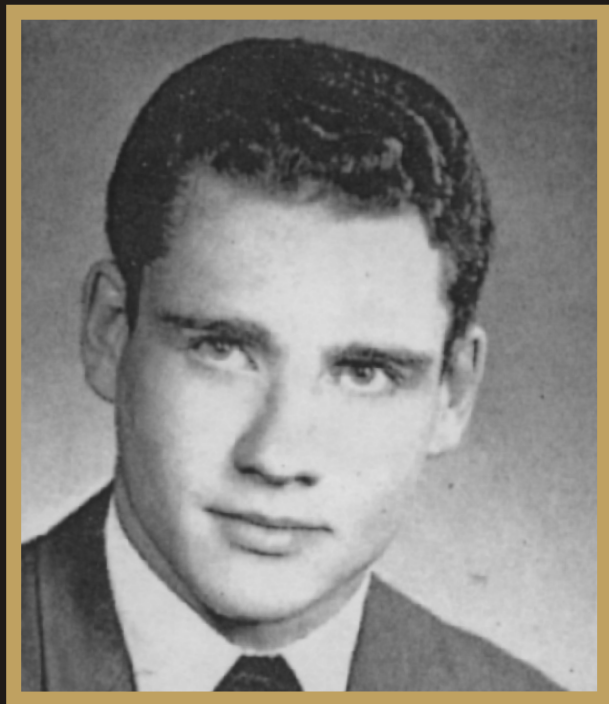
