


DON CONSTANTINE

Don Constantine, a former Miller band director, was awarded the Outstanding Miller School Educator in 1968-1969. He directed the Miller High School Band, and they were awarded champions 5 years at the Huron College Invitational. In 1972, he directed the Class A Marching Champions. He directed the SD State Fair host band for 14 consecutive years. In 1975-77, he led the state Snow Queen Pageant host band. He and his bands performed for all home football, basketball and most wrestling events. He introduced "The William Tell Overture" at the start of the Miller games. He and his bands performed for Manisphere in Winnepeg, Disney World, Sea World, and Circus World. He also directed the host band for the SD State Golden Gloves Boxing tournament. He was Miller High School Band Director for 15 years, from 1966-1981.

Leo Warnke is well known for directing the Miller pep band, marching band, and particularly the jazz band program. Three high school bands, 2 junior high bands and a high school jazz combo made up the jazz program which competed many times at festivals and competitions. Miller's Jazz I was a consistent winner when competing with bands from SD, IA, WY, MN and NE. Mr. Warnke was a director of jazz and jazz improvisation at the All State Music Camp at SDSU for many years and served as a guest clinician and conductor at numerous concert and band festivals. He is a member of Phi Beta Mu, the International Bandmaster Fraternity and was awarded Bandmaster of the Year in 2005. He was Miller High School Band Director for 26 years, from 1982-2008.
