As an athlete in high school he was a member of two undefeated teams in football in 1967 and 1968. The basketball teams were also successful including a third-place finish in the 1968 State A Tournament. He was a member of the record holding Mile Relay Team in track in 1969.

Returning to Miller in 1980 he provided medical care at home athletic events for 35 years. He has served as an official for junior varsity and junior high school football and basketball games. Other activity included pre-participation physical examinations for all athletes, as well as weight certification and skin evaluation for wrestling. As a registered official in track he starts and officiates at varsity track and field and cross country meets.

Along with spouse Connie and others he helped form the Miller Booster Club in 2000.

## MILLER RUSTLERS 1968 UNDEFEATED FOOTBALL TEAM 8 WINS 0 LOSSES 1 TIE

The 1968 Rustler Football squad ran the school's unbeaten string to 19 with an 8-0-1 season. The team showed great offensive and defensive strength. They opened the season at home against Redfield with a 13-13 deadlock and won the remainder of the games, including the Central Conference Championship. During this string, the Rustlers scored 167 points, while allowing their opponents just 25. The team finished seventh in the final poll rankings of the Sioux Falls Argus-Leader Newspaper.
