



While attending MHS, John was a 3 year varsity starter in football and basketball, along with lettering 3 years in track and one year in golf. In 1967 he was a member of the first-ever MHS boys basketball team to qualify for the Class A State Boys Basketball Tournament, by defeating Huron and Mitchell in the Sectional Tournament. That year, he was named to the 1967 Class A Boys Basketball All Tournament 2nd Team, and the 1967 Class A Boys Basketball All State 2nd team. In 1967 he was awarded the Gib Thomas Outstanding MHS Senior Athlete. In baseball he pitched the VFW Teener team to the 1965 State Championship, then later played on successful Miller Legion and Amateur baseball teams.

In 1977 he returned to Miller and for 20 years was the pharmacist/owner of Jones Drug. During that time he served on many civic boards, one being the Miller School Board, where he focused on developing athletic teams and facilities. With that goal in mind, he and his brother Jim organized and operated the Miller Youth Boys and Girls Basketball program and the Miller Youth Baseball program, fostering many future MHS stars.
